ENTRY DEADLINE: All entries must be postmarked by 02/01/10. Late entries and walk-ins will be subject to a \$10 late fee and will only be accepted if there is space available. Entries will be limited to the first 72 players to enter.

REGULATIONS: All USATT regulations apply; only USATT approved equipment may be used.

VENUE: Hardwood floor, DHS Expert Compact Tables, Nittaku 3-star Premium 40 mm Orange ball.

EVENTS: First round matches will be 2 out of 3 games to 11 points, Second Round matches will be 3 out of 5 games to 11 points.

This is a Giant Round Robin event: preliminary RR groups of 5-6 players (determined by USATT or Tournament Committee's rating) followed by a 2nd RR of 5-6 players (determined by the results of the 1st RR). Players in this event can expect to play 8 to 10 matches.

Our plan is to have two separate groups of 36 players competing. The top two players from the top two RR will compete in a cross-over elimination bracket to determine first through fourth places. This event is limited to the first 72 players who sign up on a first come, first serve basis. Doors open on Sunday at 9:00AM. Tournament will start at 9:30 AM. The tournament committee's decisions are final.

DIRECTIONS: From the North--take Freeway I-5 S, then I-405 S toward Beaverton, US-26 W. From the South, take I-5 N, and take Highway 217 exit, then US-26W (Sunset Highway). From US-26 W (Sunset Highway), take Cornell exit, turn left over the freeway, and next light turn left on 158th, turn left at the third stop lights on Schendel and proceed to the rear building (Athletic Center).

Prize Money: 1st place: \$400; 2nd place: \$200; 3rd place: \$100 and 4th place: \$50. 1st round table winners: \$20 each. 2nd round table winners: \$25 each (except the top two tables) if there are less than 65 players, 1st round table prize money will be at the Tournament Director's discretion.
